

How to solve the “not set” error message

Q.When I open imagerecall, all the text is replaced with <not set>

A. In order to solve this problem, please download the “language.ini” file that is below:

Once downloaded, please make sure that the file is placed in the image recall directory. Simply copy the file and follow these simple steps:

- Go to “My computer”
- Double click on your hard drive (Usually C)
- Double click “Program Files”
- Double click “Media innovations group”
- Double click “imagerecall 3”

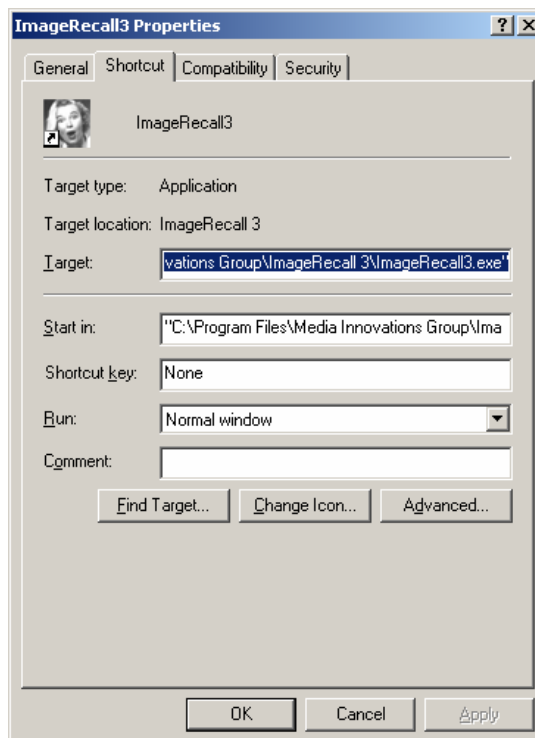
Click edit (located up the top) and click paste.

It will ask you “Do you wish to overwrite the existing file”

Click “Yes”

If you have installed image recall to an alternative directory simply RIGHT click the image recall shortcut on your desktop.

Click properties



Click “Find target” and that will open up your image recall 3 directory. From there simply paste the new language.ini file.
